The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting a feasibility study for State Highway (SH) 146, from north of Interstate Highway (IH-) 10 to north of Ferry Road in Chambers and Harris Counties. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the feasibility study with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Thursday, Aug. 8, 2024, at 5 p.m.** To view the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: go to www.txdot.gov and search keywords "SH 146 Feasibility Study". If you do not have internet access, you may call (409) 898-5820 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access study materials during the feasibility study.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. The in-person option will be held in an open house format. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of study materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on Thursday, Aug. 8, 2024, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Ross. S. Sterling High School Cafeteria, 300 W. Baker Road, Baytown, TX 77521.**

The purpose of the SH 146 Feasibility Study is to investigate existing and future transportation needs and develop conceptual alternatives (options) to improve mobility, safety, accessibility, and drainage along the SH 146 corridor, while minimizing impacts to the environment.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the study location and design, tentative schedules, and other information regarding the study are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Beaumont District located at 8350 Eastex Fwy., Beaumont, TX 77708. Please call (409) 898-5820 to make an appointment. Study materials are also available online at: www.txdot.gov and search keywords "SH 146 Feasibility Study", These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
