# State Highway 105 Widening - Sour Lake

### In-Person Public Hearing:

The TxDOT Beaumont District proposes improvements to SH 105 from 0.1 miles east of SH 326 to Pine Island Bayou in Hardin County, Texas. The proposed project would:

- Enhance traffic operations by reconstructing and expanding the existing two-lane undivided highway to a five-lane undivided highway.
- Improve safety by constructing new isolated raised center medians and improving multiple intersecting streets and driveway locations.
- Upgrade drainage by constructing three new detention basins.
- Require approximately 144.7 acres of additional right-of-way and 1.1 acres of temporary construction easements.

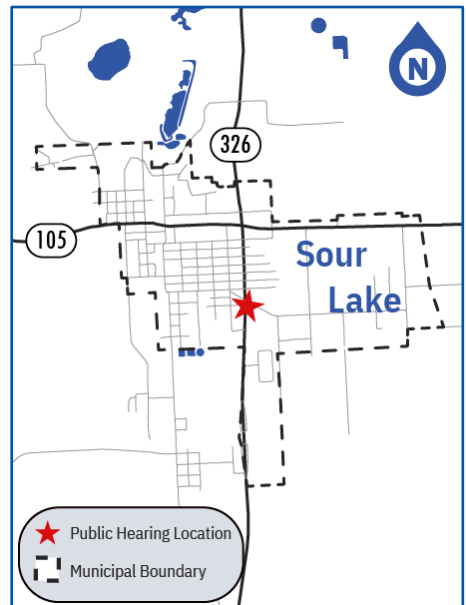
### Virtual Option:
