

MADISONVILLE AND HUNTSVILLE I-14 CENTRAL TEXAS CORRIDOR STUDY OPEN HOUSES POSTPONED

The upcoming I-14 Central Texas Corridor Study open house meetings in Madisonville and Huntsville have been postponed due to Hurricane Beryl

MADISONVILLE AND HUNTSVILLE – The I-14 open house public meetings planned in Madisonville on July 10 and Huntsville on July 11 have been postponed due to storm damage from Hurricane Beryl. The meetings scheduled at Legends Event Center in Bryan on July 17 and the Grimes County Fairgrounds in Navasota on July 18 will still proceed as planned.

TxDOT is hosting a second round of six in-person open houses with a virtual option to introduce potential opportunity areas for the future I-14 corridor and gather feedback from local communities throughout the Study area. All six open houses will contain the same Study information and exhibits.
