

SH 47 at SH 21 Interchange

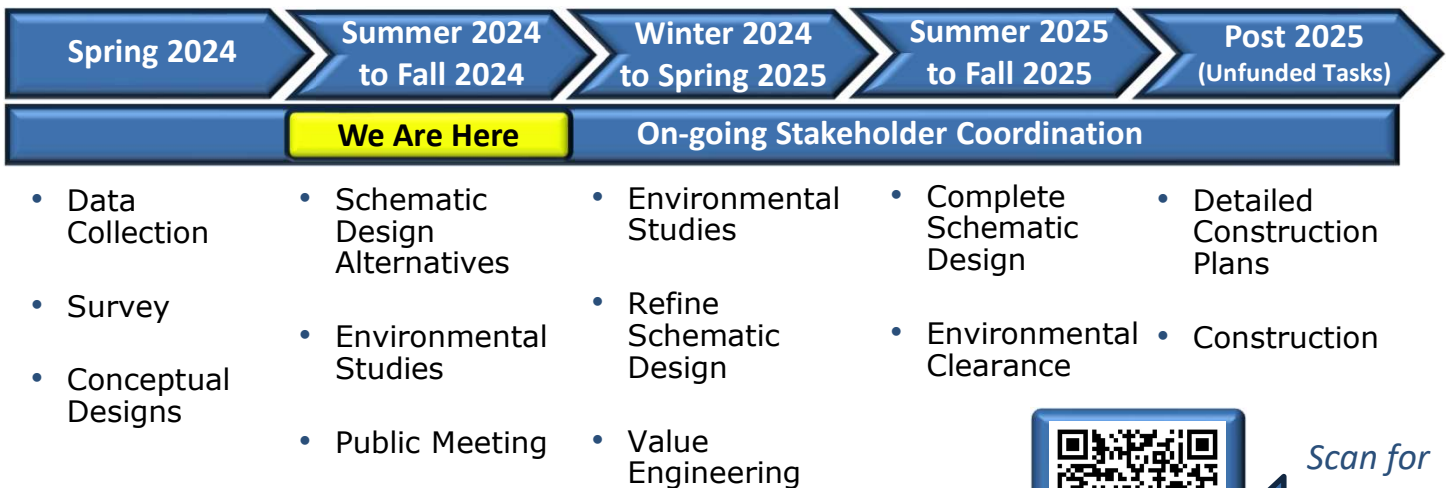
Brazos County and the TxDOT Bryan District are developing design concepts to reconfigure the SH 47 at SH 21 interchange and improve adjacent intersections along SH 21 and SH 47, within the project limits (from west of Fazzino Lane on SH 21 to north of Thompsons Creek on SH 47).

Proposed Improvements

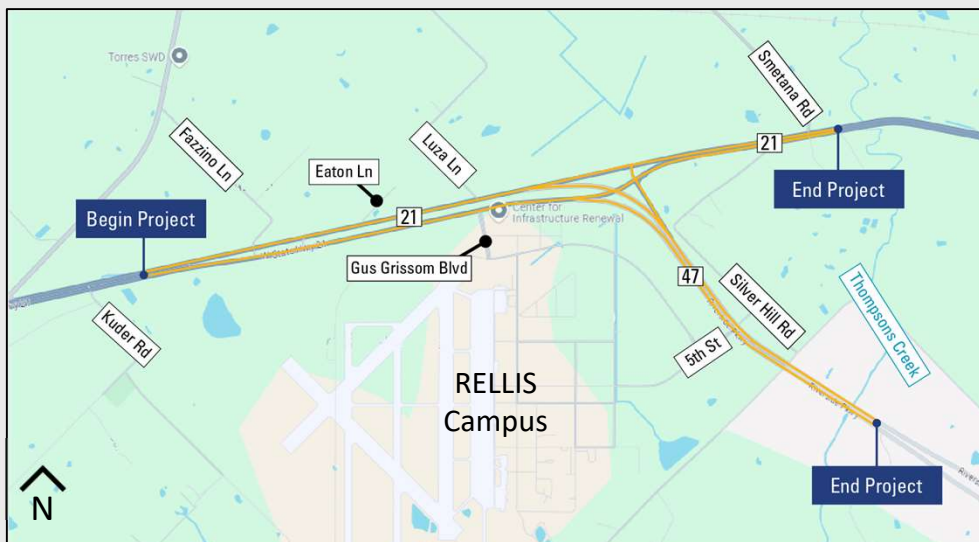
- Reconstruct the existing highways to four-lane divided highways with two lanes in each direction, separated by a concrete barrier.
- Add two-lane, one-way frontage roads along the new highway interchanges.

The proposed project would require limited right-of-way at intersecting roadways and is not anticipated to displace residential or commercial businesses.
