SH 47 at SH 21 Interchange Project

Brazos County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Bryan District is proposing improvements to the SH 47 at SH 21 interchange in Brazos County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting on the proposed project.

The meeting will be held on **Thursday, November 14, 2024, from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. at the Texas A&M University System, RELLIS Campus, Center for Infrastructure Renewal, 1041 RELLIS Parkway, Bryan, Texas 77807**. Attendees will be able to come and go as they please to review project displays and ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants in an open house format. The purpose of the meeting is to present the proposed project and receive public comment. On the day of the public meeting, the information presented will be made available online on the TxDOT website www.txdot.gov, keyword search "SH 47 at SH 21 Interchange".

The proposed project would reconfigure the SH 47 at SH 21 interchange and improve adjacent intersections along SH 21 and SH 47, to enhance safety, reduce congestion, maintain local connectivity and improve mobility within the project limits. The project length is approximately 2.9 miles.

The proposed project, subject to final design considerations, would require limited areas of right of way. Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT Bryan Right-of-Way office by calling (979) 778-9716.

The proposed project could involve construction in a floodplain and wetlands. Once the schematic design is developed further, environmental analysis will be conducted to identify and assess impacts.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection by appointment Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Bryan District Office located at 2591 North Earl Rudder Freeway, Bryan, Texas 77803, (979) 778-9231. This information also will be available for inspection at the meeting.

The public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. Written comments from the public regarding the proposed project are requested and may be presented at the meeting. All comments must be received on or before Monday, December 2, 2024, to be included as part of the official meeting record.
