Mesa Street – State Highway (SH) 20 Corridor Study
From Doniphan Drive (SH 20) to Cesar Chavez Border Highway (Loop 375)

What is the Mesa Street – SH 20 Corridor Study?

A Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Traffic Engineering and Planning Study that supports the following TxDOT goals and objectives:

- Safety;
- Congestion relief; and
- Transportation reliability.

With these goals in mind, the study is developing a master plan of recommended short-, mid- and long-term transportation solutions to improve the Mesa St. – SH 20 corridor from Doniphan Drive (SH 20) to Cesar Chavez Border Highway (Loop 375), a length of approximately 9.8 miles.

Who is involved in the study?

Agency coordination includes the City of El Paso, the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization, the University of Texas at El Paso, stakeholders and other local transportation and corridor-related offices.
