

Six-County Multimodal Study

El Paso District

Overview

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) El Paso District is conducting a six-county multimodal study to learn about mobility, transportation, and development challenges and opportunities within the area. The study will consider infrastructure, transportation policies and programs. The six counties include El Paso, Hudspeth, Culberson, Jeff Davis, Presidio and Brewster.

Why is the study needed?

The study will result in a solutions framework that will enable TxDOT El Paso District to address mobility needs within the six counties. The framework will take into consideration multiple modes of travel, including cycling; walking/hiking; transit services including bus, airports and rail; shared mobility services including medical-related services, etc. Analysts will be looking at:

- What mobility infrastructure and services exist?
- What performs adequately?
- What new structures and services are proposed?
- What gaps remain and what opportunities exist?

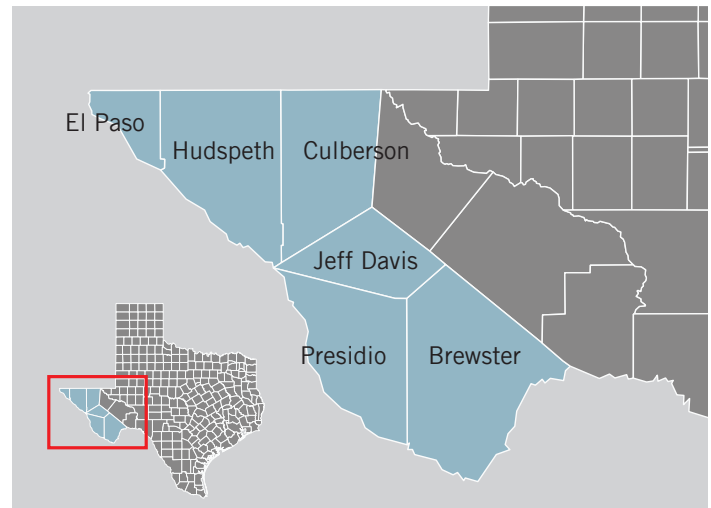


Your participation is vital.

How will we gather your input?

TxDOT will be conducting listening sessions and surveys. Approximately 30 listening sessions will be held in person and online with key stakeholders in a thoughtful and equitable manner. Surveys will enable the study team to validate data, as well as receive stakeholder feedback at pivotal points along the course of the study.

What happens after this study?

This study is a critical first step in TxDOT's project planning process. This step will give TxDOT a way to assess and identify projects for possible implementation. Once a project or projects are identified, then technical studies, as well as stakeholder and public outreach, will take place.
