These roadways include US and state highways with frontage roads and/or shoulders allowing for bicycling activities and city streets with sidewalks and/or shoulders.

Projects


- **SH 180 from NW 6th Street to NE 5th Street**
 - City of Grand Prairie – Dallas County
 - Roadway reconstruction from a 4-lane to a 2-lane divided roadway to add parking and bicycle lanes
 - 0.72 mile
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2030
- **N Jefferson Street from Wintergreen Road to E Pleasant Run Road; E Pleasant Run Road from N Jefferson Street to Lancaster-Hutchins Road**
 - City of Lancaster – Dallas County
 - Widen and reconstruct to a 4-lane divided roadway with bicycle lanes
 - 1.34 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2029
- **Prairie Creek Road from North of Military Parkway to North of Forney Road**
 - City of Dallas – Dallas County
 - Construction to physically separate Prairie Creek Road and the Union Pacific Railroad and add bicycle lanes
 - 0.98 mile
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2030
- **West Commerce Street from Fort Worth Avenue to Riverfront Boulevard**
 - City of Dallas – Dallas County
 - Construct sidewalks and bicycle lanes
 - 1.12 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2029
- **Park Lane from Greenville Avenue to Hemlock Avenue**
 - City of Dallas – Dallas County
 - Roadway reconstruction and striping of 4 travel lanes, a left turn lane, bicycle lanes, sidewalks, and intersection improvements at Shady Brook
 - 0.37 mile
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2029
- **Fair Oaks Avenue from Ridgcrest Road to Walnut Lane in Dallas**
 - City of Dallas – Dallas County
 - Construction of bicycle lanes along Fair Oaks Avenue
 - 1.12 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2029
