Introduction

Welcome, and thank you for attending the 2024 public hearing for the Fort Worth District to present its transportation projects, programs, and policies affecting bicycle use on the state highway system.

These roadways include US and state highways with frontage roads and/or shoulders allowing for bicycling activities, and city streets with sidewalks and/or shoulders.

TxDOT Policies

TxDOT design guidelines for bicycle and pedestrian facilities were updated in December 2022 and include guidance for Urban, Urban Core, Suburban, and Rural Towns for new construction, reconstruction, or widening projects and projects involving bridge replacement, bridge deck replacement, or bridge rehabilitation. Projects

- **Miller Avenue from East 1st Street to Richardson Street**
 - City of Fort Worth – Tarrant County
 - Restriping the road for bicycles, adding separators to existing bicycle lanes, installing new signals for bicycles and pedestrians, and improving intersections
 - 1.30 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2027
- **US 180 from West of Spur 312 to East of Elm Street**
 - City of Weatherford – Parker County
 - Roadway reconstruction, adding a bike lane, and upgrading for ADA compliance
 - 1.16 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2029
- **Horne Street from Vickery Boulevard to Camp Bowie Boulevard**
 - City of Fort Worth – Tarrant County
 - Widening to a 3-lane roadway with bicycle lanes, sidewalk, and traffic signal improvements.
 - 1.38 miles
 - Approximate Completion Date: 2028
