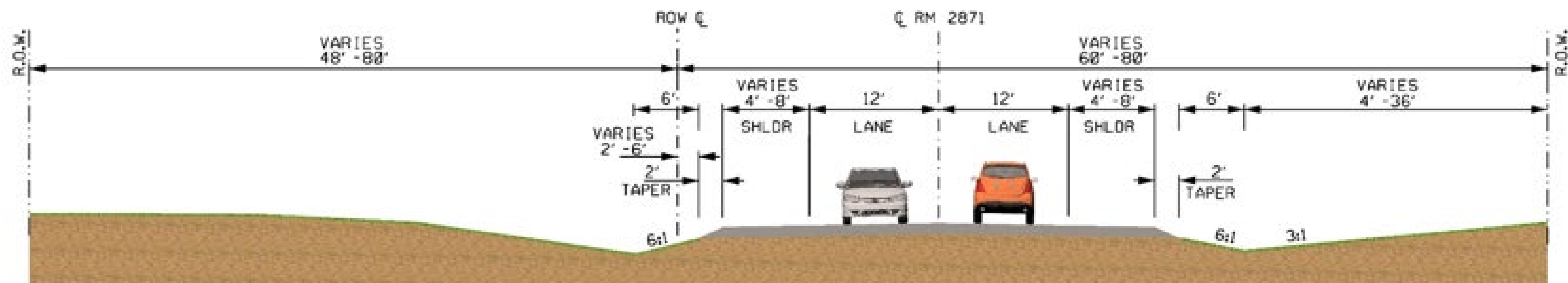

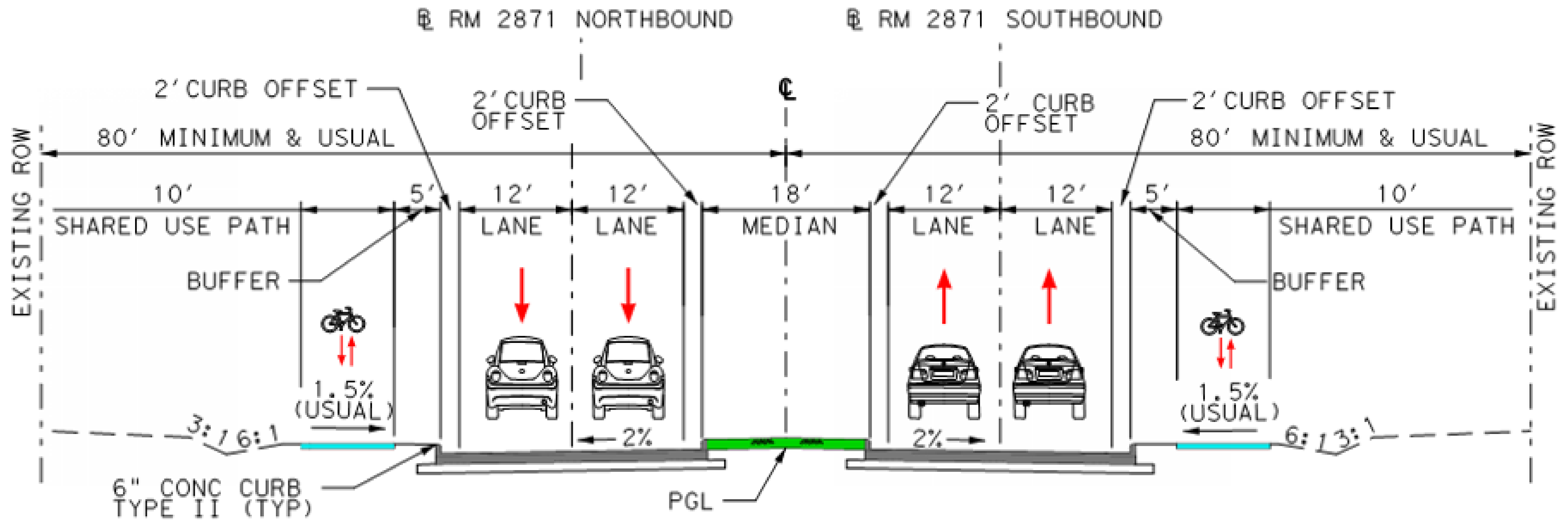

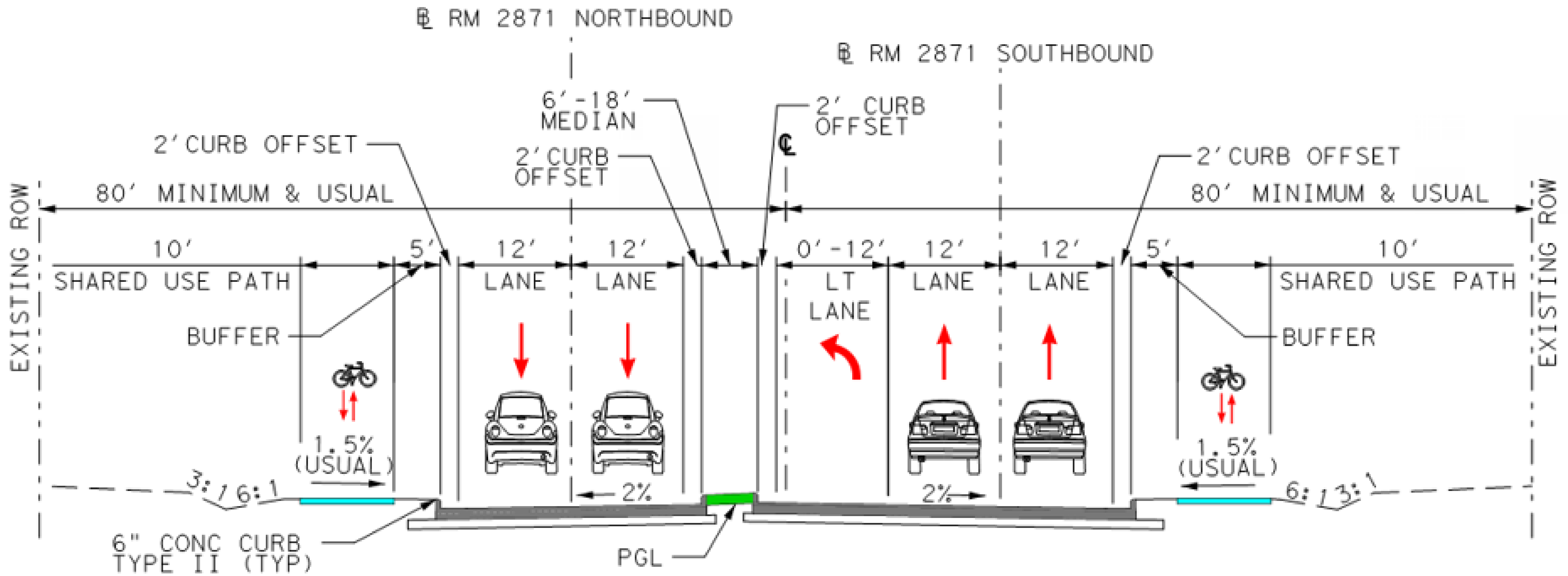


Proposed Standard Typical Section

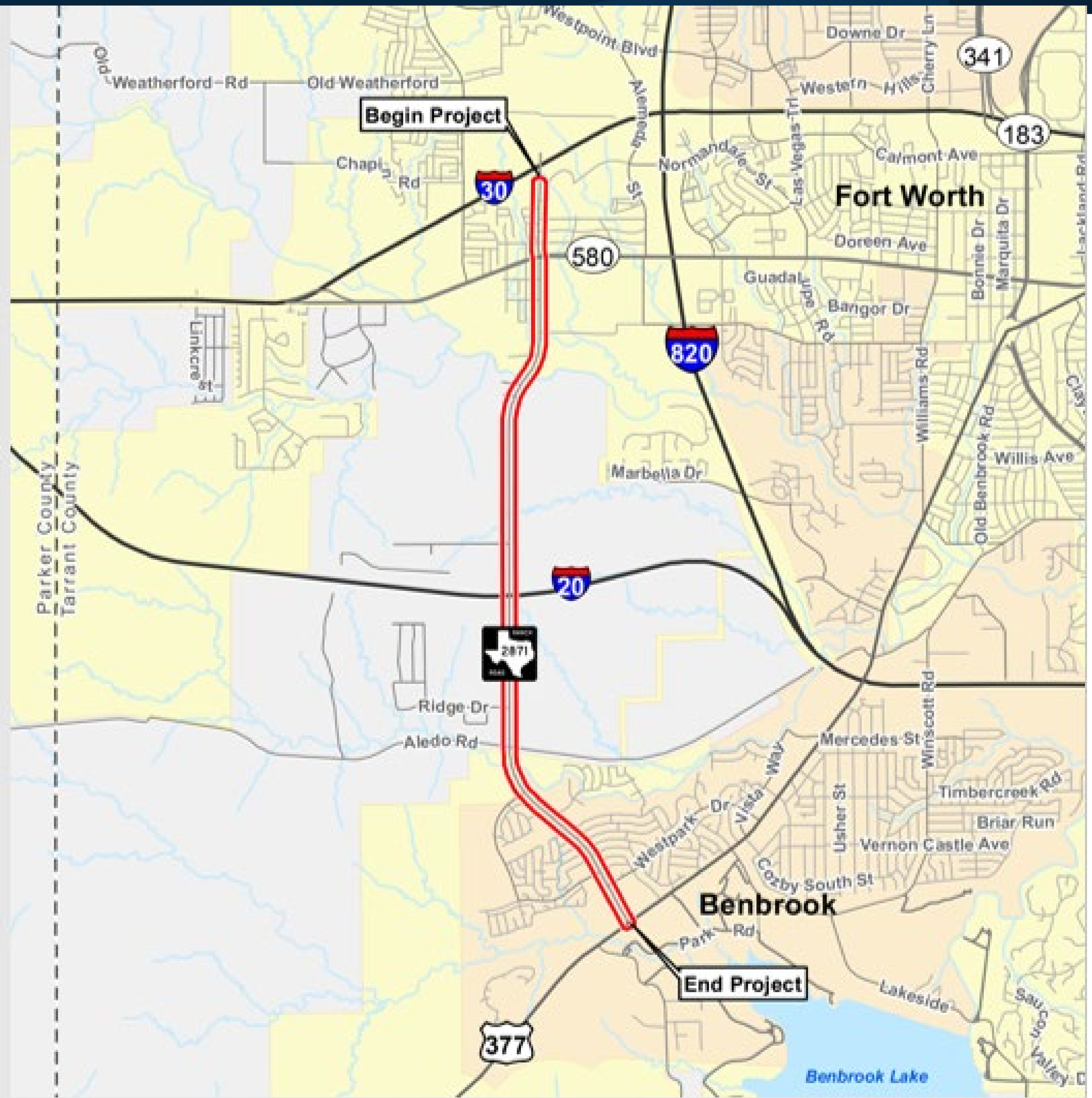

Project Need

Inadequate capacity to meet current and projected traffic volumes for increasing traffic congestion

Provide safe passage over the railroad and for pedestrians and bicyclists

The proposed improvements to RM 2871 include:

- Reconstructing and widening RM 2871 between I-30 and U.S. 377.
- Relieve congestion on RM 2871 at the Union Pacific Railroad intersection and Aledo Road.
- Intersection improvements throughout the corridor.
- Provide bicycle and pedestrian accommodations.

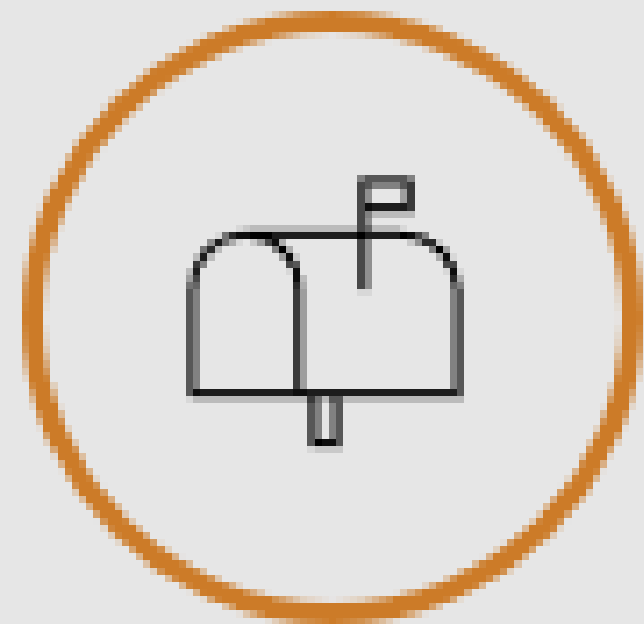

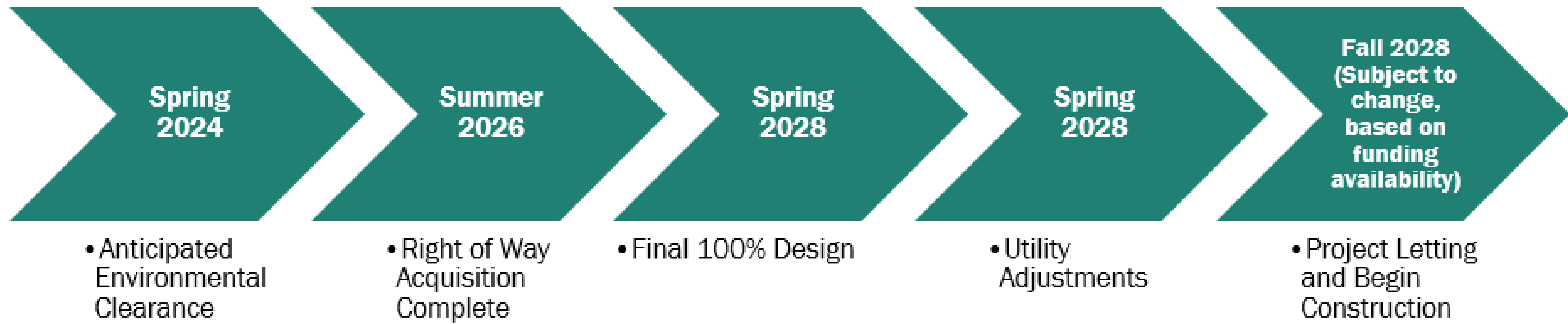
