



Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option 2027 – 2030 Rural Transportation Improvement Program

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) – Fort Worth District will conduct an online virtual public meeting with in-person options for the 2027-2030 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP). The purpose is to provide information and receive comments on which transportation projects may be coming to your area. The Fort Worth District includes Erath Jack Palo Pinto and Somervell counties. The Rural TIP includes both grouped projects and individually listed projects that include added capacity and regionally significant projects to be funded outside of Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPO) boundary, and within a TxDOT district during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding. This meeting offers the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed priorities. The Rural TIP is the first step on the road to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
