The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing the construction of a northbound exit ramp on SH 199 between Denver Trail and Skylark Drive to provide immediate access to the Texas Health Hospital in Azle, Tarrant County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an in-person public meeting on the proposed project. **The in-person meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 4, 2024 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Azle High School Administration Building SWARM Room at 1200 Boyd Rd, Azle, TX 76020.** Attendees will be able to view an on-screen presentation, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments.

TxDOT is proposing the construction of a northbound exit ramp on SH 199 between Denver Trail and Skylark Drive to provide immediate access to the Texas Health Hospital in Azle, Texas. The proposed project will include any improvements to the SH 199 main lanes and frontage roads necessary to accommodate the proposed exit ramp (e.g., deceleration lanes). The goal of this project is to increase safety, enhance mobility, and most importantly improve access to the regional hospital.

The proposed project will involve construction in wetlands.

The proposed project will not involve action within in a floodplain.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and **available by appointment only** for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Fort Worth District Office, 2501 Southwest Loop 820, Fort Worth, TX 76133. Project materials are also available online at www.txdot.gov, keyword search: "SH 199 Ramp from Denver Trail to Skylar Drive" once they have been prepared.

The in-person public meeting will be conducted in English. Project materials will be available in English and Spanish. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.
