The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public meeting to solicit input on an access management study for State Highway (SH) 3 from Brookglen Drive to the Harris/Galveston County line on Tuesday, February 27, 2018, from 5:30 – 7:30 p.m. The meeting will take place at the City of Webster Civic Center, 311 Pennsylvania Avenue, Webster, TX 77598. The meeting will be held in an open house format where the public may come and go at their convenience and provide comments at any point. Staff will be available to answer questions; no formal presentation is planned.

The purpose of access management is to provide vehicular access to land development in a manner that preserves the safety and efficiency of the transportation system. The study aims to identify short-, medium-, and long-range improvements to reduce crashes, improve mobility, and support existing and future development.

Maps of the study corridor and exhibits will be available at the public meeting. This information is also available for review by appointment Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding state holidays, at the TxDOT Houston District Office, 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, TX 77007.
