### Proposed Improvements to Loop 286 in Paris, TX - Lamar County CSJs: 1690-001-123, 1690-001-124, 1690-001-125

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing improvements to Loop 286 around Paris, Texas, a total project length of approximately 15.5 miles. **TxDOT will conduct a public meeting to discuss and receive public comments on the proposed project.** Representatives from TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements. The purpose of the study is to analyze potential roadway improvements for Loop 286. Improvements could require additional right-of-way to accommodate the project.
