Virtual Public Meeting with an In-Person Open House Option

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) invites you to a virtual public meeting with an in-person open house option. TxDOT is proposing to redesign FM 3248 (E. Alton Gloor Blvd.) from I-69E to FM 1847. The purpose of the public meeting is to present the preliminary transportation design and receive public comments.

FM 3248 (E. Alton Gloor Blvd.)

TxDOT is proposing to redesign FM 3248 (E. Alton Gloor Blvd.) from I-69E to FM 1847 from an existing five-lane roadway with a continuous left turn lane to a six-lane roadway with a raised median and a 10-foot-wide shared use path in each direction in Cameron County. The project is approximately 2.1 miles long. The existing right of way will be expanded from 120 feet to 140 feet.

The purpose of the proposed FM 3248 project is to reduce congestion and improve mobility and safety.
