Project Description

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to redesign FM 3248 (E. Alton Gloor Blvd.) from I-69E to FM 1847 from an existing five-lane roadway with a continuous left turn lane to a six-lane roadway with a raised median and a 10-foot-wide shared use path in each direction in Cameron County.

Purpose of the Project

The purpose of the proposed FM 3248 project is to reduce congestion and improve mobility and safety.

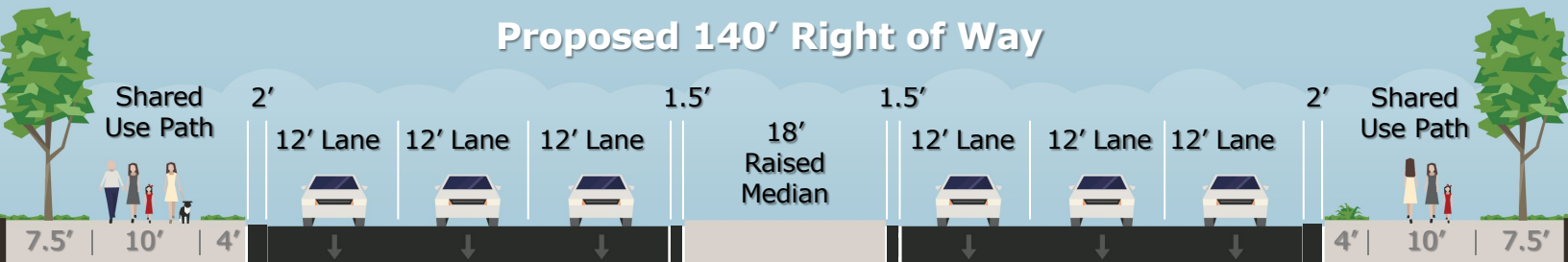

Estimated Project Milestones

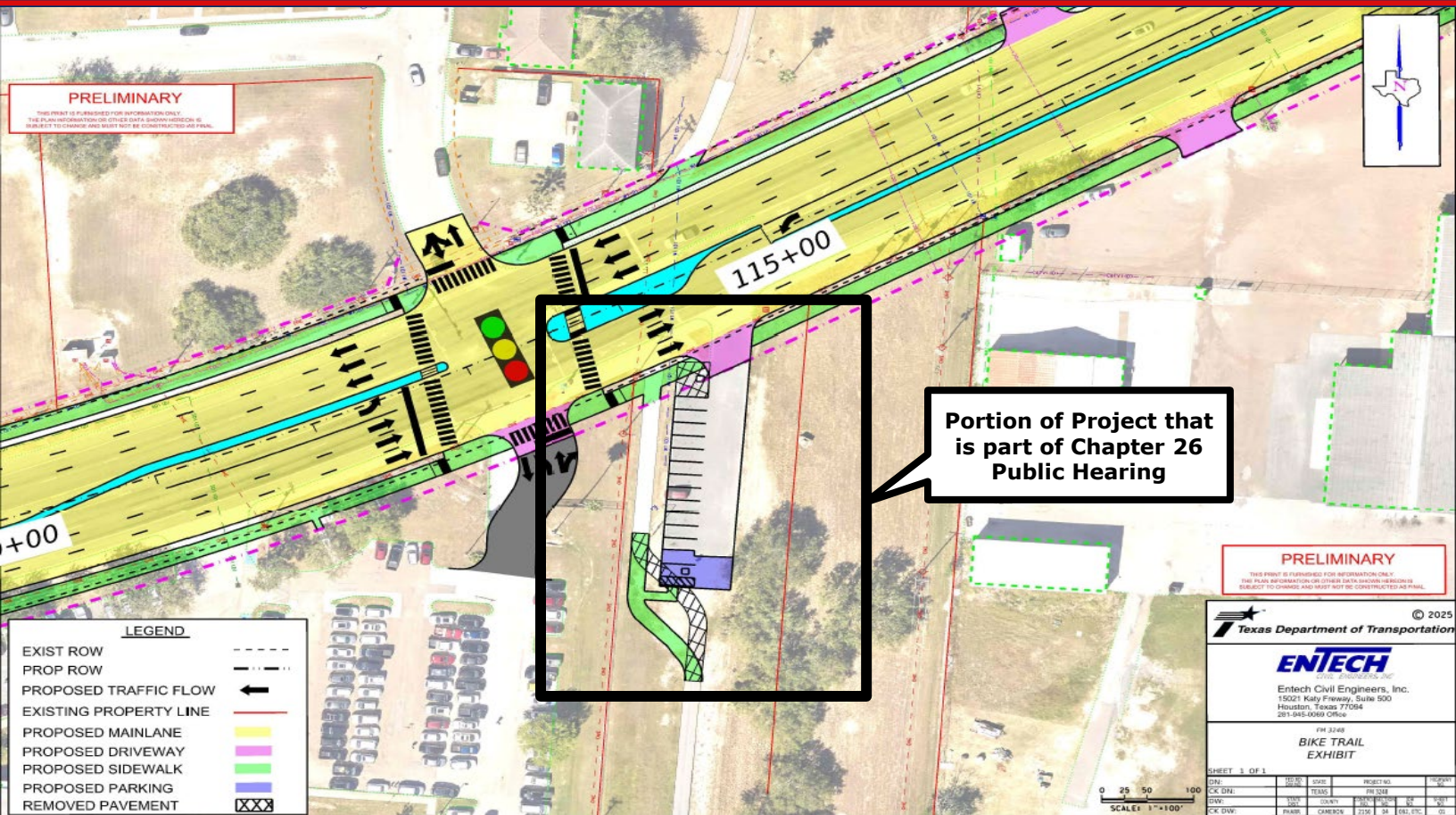

Chapter 26 Public Hearing Information



Why are we here?

- The proposed design is subject to Chapter 26 of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Code and Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966 due to proposed right-of-way takings from a designated public property i.e., the Brownsville Historic Battlefield Hike and Bike Trail.
- Analysis of impacts under Chapter 26 and Section 4(f) is conducted as part of the environmental process, which is subject to the National Environmental Policy Act, or NEPA.

What are potential trail impacts?

The proposed project would impact approximately 0.05 acre (22 feet) of the Brownsville Historic Battlefield Hike and Bike Trail, and associated parking.

Efforts to minimize impacts

- The realignment of trail property would not affect the features, attributes, or activities qualifying the trail for protection under Section 4(f) and therefore intends to make a de minimis impact determination under 23 CFR 774.3(b). The following efforts are proposed to minimize impacts:
- Replace two parking spaces (one ADA compliant) and ramp
 - Realign Trail
