International Bridge Trade Corridor (IBTC)

From 365 Tollway and FM 493 to I-2

Hidalgo County, Texas

This notice advises the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed International Bridge Trade Corridor (IBTC) project, and that the FONSI is available for public review. The proposed project would construct a controlled access six-lane divided non-tolled roadway on new location from 365 Tollway and FM 493 to I-2 in Hidalgo County, Texas.

The FONSI and approved final environmental assessment (EA) are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Pharr District, 600 W. I-2, Pharr, TX 78577 at 956-702-6200. They are also available online at www.Txdot.gov (keyword search: "IBTC").
