Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option
US 83 Menard Feasibility Study
From US 190 North of Menard to FM 2291 South of Menard
Menard County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) San Angelo District is conducting a feasibility study of alternate routes for US 83 in and around the City of Menard in Menard County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting with an in-person option as an opportunity for the public to provide feedback on potential locations for routes to alleviate congestion and enhance safety. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Thursday, May 9, 2024, at noon, and will remain online until Friday, May 24, 2024 at 11:59 p.m.** To view the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above www.txdot.gov and search "US 83 Menard Study". If you do not have internet access, you may call Russell Pehl, P.E., CFM, TxDOT Project Manager, at (325) 944-1501 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access feasibility study materials during the study development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. The in-person option will be held in an open house format. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting, review hard copies of feasibility study materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and/or consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on Thursday, May 9, 2024, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Menard High School Community Center located at 303 Travis Street, Menard, TX 76859.**

The San Angelo District is hosting this meeting as an opportunity for the public to provide feedback and comments on potential locations for alternate routes in and around the City of Menard to alleviate congestion and enhance safety.

Any materials shown at the public meeting are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT District Office at 4502 Knickerbocker Road, San Angelo, TX 76904, and (325) 944-1501. These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs.
