Project Overview

The proposed project would extend for approximately 26 miles along US 83, which currently consists of a rural two-lane undivided highway with alternating Super-2 passing lanes within a 120-foot-wide right of way. The proposed project would evaluate alignment alternatives to widen US 83 within a 370-foot-wide right of way.

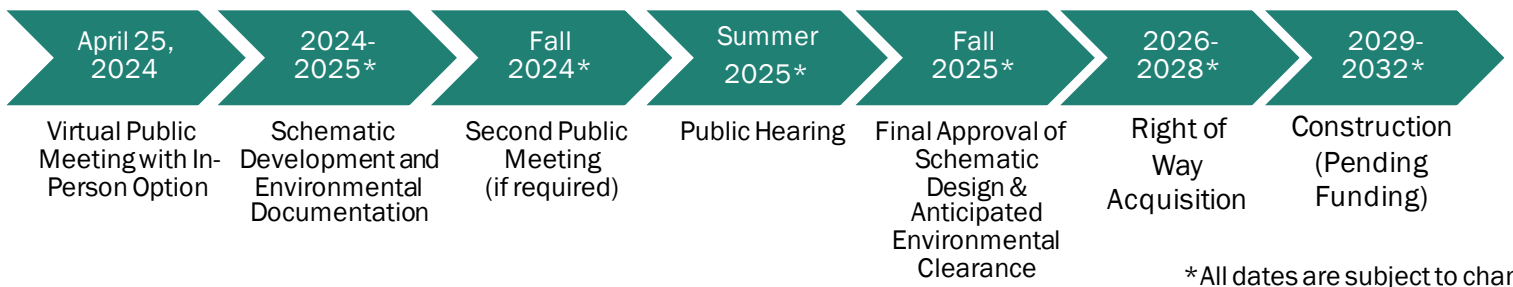
The proposed project would be constructed in two phases;

- Phase I (interim design) would primarily widen US 83 to a four-lane divided highway;
- Phase II (ultimate design) would widen US 83 to a controlled-access interstate system by constructing frontage roads on either side of the interim design mainlanes.

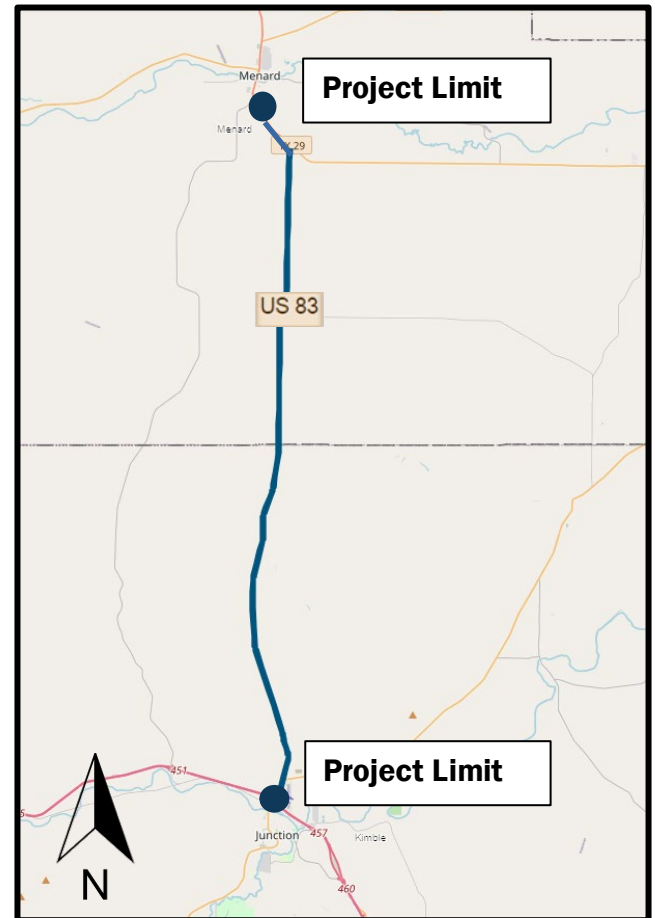
