



**Notice of Public Meeting**  
**11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> Streets and Gurley Lane Sidewalk and Bicycle Lanes**  
**CSJ: 0909-22-181**  
**McLennan County, Texas**

The City of Waco is proposing to improve 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Streets from Columbus Avenue and Gurley Lane from 10<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> Streets in McLennan County, Texas. The project is the result of funding received from a TxDOT Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside program grant. Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 2, Subchapter E, §2.107 and Code of Federal Regulations, Title 23, Chapter I, Subchapter H, §771.111 and Title 40, Chapter V, §1506, this notice advises the public that the City of Waco will be conducting a public meeting to discuss and receive public comments on the proposed project. **The meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 5, 2018, at the South Waco Library, 2737 South 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Waco, Texas, 76706.** Representatives from the City of Waco, TxDOT and project consultants will be available to answer questions about the proposed project improvements. **The public meeting will be held in an open house format from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., and will include a brief project overview presentation beginning at 5:15 p.m.**

The proposed improvements include adding pavement markings and signage for 6' wide bicycle lanes within the existing roadway and in-filling 6' wide sidewalks in areas where there are gaps or segments of structural damage in the existing sidewalks. The bicycle lanes begin on 11<sup>th</sup> Street at Columbus Avenue and continue along 12<sup>th</sup> Street to Garden Avenue. The 6' wide sidewalks will be constructed along the east side of 12<sup>th</sup> Street from Kennedy Circle to Brown Avenue; on the west side of 12<sup>th</sup> Street from Carter Drive to Gurley Lane; and primarily on the east side of Gurley Lane from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 27<sup>th</sup> Street. ADA compliant ramps will also be constructed at driveways and street intersections, with pedestrian crosswalks added where necessary. Additional right-of-way was required based on the current design.

Maps will be displayed at the meeting depicting the location of proposed improvements and the geometric design are available for inspection Monday through Saturday between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the South Waco Library, 2737 South 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Waco, Texas 76706.

Written comments from the public regarding the project are requested and may be presented at the meeting or submitted in person or by mail to Ms. Janet Sheguit, BSP Engineers, 15 W. Central Avenue, Temple, TX 76501. **Written comments must be received or postmarked on or before Thursday, September 20, 2018 to be included in the documentation of the public meeting.**

The public meeting will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs, such as the need for an interpreter, are encouraged to contact Janet Sheguit at BSP Engineers, 254-774-9611. Requests should be made at least two days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate these needs.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
