

# I-35 from SH 123 to Posey Road FACT SHEET

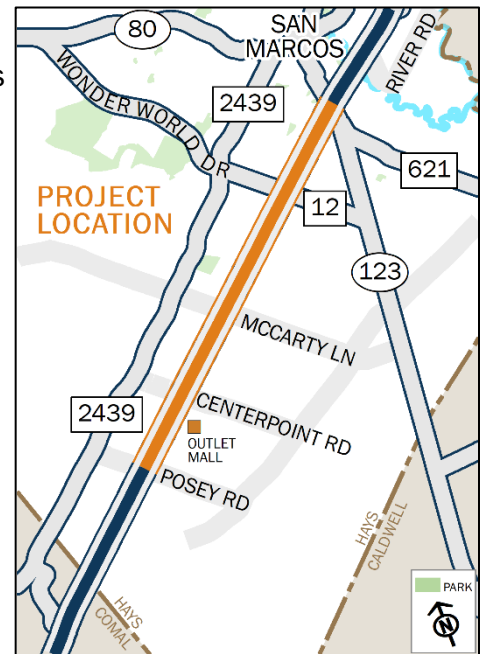
## Why Improvements Are Needed

Population growth in Hays County has increased congestion along the I-35 corridor, which serves as the backbone of the local, regional and national transportation network. Lack of mobility on I-35 threatens the economic livelihood of those who rely on the highway. The proposed project is designed to improve safety and mobility in this area.

## Project Overview

We are taking a smart approach to transportation planning in order to improve safety and mobility along the I-35 corridor. This project proposes to:

- Reconstruct the I-35 mainlanes and frontage roads
- Add capacity and shift the northbound and southbound I-35 frontage roads
- Add auxiliary lanes along the I-35 mainlanes and frontage roads
- Reverse the entrance and exit ramps
- Improve the I-35 intersections at Wonder World Drive, McCarty Lane and Centerpoint Road
- Improve bicycle and pedestrian paths



## Timeline

The environmental study and schematic design are currently underway and are anticipated to be complete in 2023. Finalized plans, specifications and estimates (PS&E) would begin upon completion of the environmental study. Construction could begin as early as 2026 and would be contingent on funding.
